- 16 Pounds– On the rack behind lane 24

In order for Franklin Lanes to keep each person safe, we ask that you, as the customer, follow these guidelines.

1. All transactions will be prepaid to limit interaction.
2. We ask that if there is a wait, please keep your distance from others. If you wish to wait outside, or in your car, we will be happy to text you to inform you when your lane is available.
3. We will not have more than 6 people / lane.
4. Only 50% of our lanes will be used at a time. We will use a staggered approach using every other lane
5. If you are in need of a bowling ball ramp, please let an employee know, and we will be happy to bring you a sanitized ramp.
6. When you have finished your bowling, please leave any food, drinks, bowling shoes, as well as bowling balls on your lane. An employee will come to sanitize the equipment and area.
7. Hand sanitizer dispensers will be located throughout the building for your convenience.
8. Food and Beverage services will be limited. Only single use condiments and disposable silverware will be used.
